

19 – Gli occhiali del Malconsiglio – 8 km – 340 m difference in height (hunting area)

For this tour we will park in the same square before Il Doccino that we used to go to Le Marie (route 17).

At the parking lot, on the left side of the road, we take a small road marked with a white and red trail sign. We follow it, taking care at a certain point to turn right uphill.

We are in the middle of the woods that surround Poggio del Malconsiglio.

Continuing still slightly uphill, we will reach a vast grassy clearing dotted with boulders, called Campo a Quaranta.

Our path continues forward, always in the woods and leads us to the ruins of a farm with a superb view of the sea.

Continuing in the same direction, we arrive at a crossroads: to the left we go towards the locality of Nocolino, while our itinerary takes us to the right, where, after a while, we find the clearing of the Gabbrigioli, where we have already been with the ring of the Sassi Whites (28).

From here we continue straight, towards the clearing of the Madia (already seen also this coming in the opposite direction from the Sassi Bianchi).

At Madia we can have a snack and then take the path to the right which, always crossing a beautiful wooded and flat area, will bring us back after a short descent on the outward road, which we will take to the right to find ourselves shortly after in Campo a Quaranta.

At the end of the clearing a path branches off to the left and uphill (ignore the flat one). We follow it by climbing gradually on the other side of Poggio del Malconsiglio, until we reach the wind turbines.

We follow the small road along the ridge to the intersection from which we passed to go to Le Marie (route 17), but this time we turn right towards Riparbella and, after the Doccino, we find our cars.
